

Crypto Airdrops Quickstart (Beginner-Friendly)

What this is

Airdrops are free token distributions used by crypto projects to attract users. Some are valuable, many are not. This guide helps you do it safely and efficiently.

Before you start (5 minutes)

- Create a new email only for crypto.
- Use a password manager + unique passwords.
- Turn on 2FA everywhere.
- Never share your seed phrase. Ever.

Your “Airdrop Setup”

- **Wallet:** Create a fresh wallet for airdrops (separate from your main funds).
- **Network basics:** Know what chain you’re using (Ethereum, Solana, etc.).
- **Small gas budget (optional):** Some chains require small fees. Start tiny.

How to find legit airdrops

Look for:

- Official project website + verified socials
- Clear documentation / roadmap

- • Reputable coverage (not random spam sites)
- Avoid:
- • “Connect wallet to claim huge rewards” with pressure timers
- • Asking for seed phrase
- • Fake “support” DMs

Simple “Airdrop Workflow”

| 1 | 1 | Verify the project (official links only) |
| 2 | 2 | Read requirements (tasks / eligibility) |
| 3 | 3 | Create a checklist of tasks |
| 4 | 4 | Complete tasks slowly & safely |
| 5 | 5 | Track what you did (date + wallet used) |
| 6 | 6 | If tokens arrive, decide: hold / sell / ignore |

Time plan (30 minutes/day)

- • 10 min: research & verify projects
- • 10 min: do tasks
- • 10 min: update your tracker

What success looks like

- • You don’t chase every airdrop.

- - You build a small pipeline of safe actions.
- - You avoid scams and protect your main wallet.
